Contest Rules

Please carefully follow directions!

- 11" x 17" (ledger size) paper or poster board **ONLY** (Other sizes will be disqualified.)
- Original artwork only.
- Color or black & white posters accepted.
- **NO** computer generated posters accepted.
- **NO** three-dimensional posters accepted.
- **NO** trademark or publicly known figures accepted.
- **The theme must be noted somewhere on the front of the poster.**
- **Back** of poster must indicate: Student's name, school, grade, teacher & phone #. It must be legible to be qualified.
- Posters will become property of CASAC.



PRIZES :

- 1 Grand Prize: \$100.00 (Best Overall)
- 3 First Prizes: \$50.00 (1 each category)
- 3 Second Prizes: \$25.00 (1 each category)
- 3 Third Prizes: \$20.00 (1 each category)

CATEGORIES:

- A) Grades 3, 4 & 5
- B) Grades 6, 7 & 8
- C) Grades 9, 10, 11 & 12

Each participant will receive a certificate of participation when posters are dropped off at the CASAC office by March 2, 2012. A preliminary judging will eliminate all but 4 posters in each category. All posters will be displayed during April at the James Prendergast Library in Jamestown or the Darwin R. Barker Library in Fredonia.

The 12 Finalist's names will be announced on March 14, 2012.
